

C.T.A. Schaffter is widely recognized as a distinguished business leader and sports administrator in Sri Lanka, with a career spanning over six decades across the insurance, corporate, and sporting sectors. Often referred to as the 'Father of Insurance in Sri Lanka,' he is the Founder and Chairman Emeritus of JXG (Janashakthi Group), one of the country's leading financial conglomerates.

A versatile sportsman, Mr. Schaffter represented Ceylon internationally in cricket and hockey during the 1950s, competing against visiting international sides and leading teams to national titles. His involvement in sport continued in administration, serving as Chairman of the National Cricket Selection Committee and holding senior roles in the Sri Lanka Hockey Federation, Colombo Hockey Association, and Tamil Union Cricket and Athletic Club. He managed the Sri Lankan national cricket team at major tournaments, including the 1999 ICC Cricket World Cup and ICC Champions Trophy, and played a key role in the historic national team tour to Jaffna in 2002.

In the insurance sector, Mr. Schaffter held senior leadership roles, including at Eagle Insurance, and served as President of the Insurance Association of Sri Lanka (IASL). As Founder of Janashakthi Insurance PLC, he built it into one of Sri Lanka's foremost insurance providers, renowned for its customer focus and alignment with national priorities.

His lifetime of service has been recognized with numerous accolades: the Lifetime Achievement Award at the 16th Asia Insurance Industry Awards, Malaysia (2012); the LMD Lifetime Achievement Award (2015); the Platinum Award for Lifetime Achievement at the Sri Lanka Insurance Industry Awards (2016); and the Lifetime Achievement Award at the Sri Lanka Cricket Awards (2024), reflecting his enduring impact on both corporate and sporting spheres.

Mr. Schaffter's legacy is defined by his dedication to institution-building, talent development, and advancing the nation's broader interests. His life's work embodies excellence, leadership, and the sustainable growth of both business and sport in Sri Lanka.

Justice Shiranee Tilakawardane is a former Acting Chief Justice of Sri Lanka and one of the country's most distinguished jurists, with nearly four decades of judicial service across all levels of court, including the apex courts. Internationally respected for her leadership on judicial integrity and ethics, she serves as Deputy Chair of the Judicial Integrity Group and is currently working with the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC) on revisions to the Commentaries on the Bangalore Principles of Judicial Conduct.

Justice Tilakawardane brings deep expertise as a judicial educator, accredited mediator, and arbitrator. She is a former consultant to the Sri Lankan Judicial Training Institute and has spent over a decade training judges, particularly newly appointed judges, on human rights law, gender justice, domestic violence, child rights, environmental law, artificial intelligence and the law, judicial decision-making, and judgment writing. Her work as an international consultant and educator spans more than thirty years, with a sustained focus on human rights, gender equality, child rights, technology, and environmental governance.

Her global engagement includes serving on the International Advisory Board of the U.S. National Center for State Courts and contributing as an international expert on gender stereotypes and judicial reasoning. Reflecting her ongoing thought leadership at the intersection of law, ethics, technology, and sustainability, Justice Tilakawardane has recently delivered keynote and plenary sessions in Odisha, India, on artificial intelligence and environmental sustainability. She continues to lecture widely on the climate impacts of AI and sustainable development, including most recently at the Wildlife & Nature Protection Society's monthly lecture in November 2025.

Dr. Indrajith Coomaraswamy has a Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Economics and Master of Arts in Economics from the University of Cambridge and a Doctor of Philosophy in Economics from the University of Sussex.

Dr Coomaraswamy is the former Governor of the Central Bank of Sri Lanka. He was a member of the Monetary Policy Consultative Committee of the Central Bank of Sri Lanka from 2013 - 2015 and an Advisor to the Ministry of Development Strategies and International Trade from 2015-2016. Prior to this, Dr Coomaraswamy held several senior level positions at the Commonwealth Secretariat in London. He joined the Commonwealth Secretariat in 1990 as Chief Officer - Economics in the International Finance and Markets Section and progressed to become the Director of the Economics Affairs Division and Deputy Director, Secretary General's office before leaving in 2008. He previously served as a Non-Executive Independent Director at John Keells Holdings PLC and Dialog Axiata Group, and currently serves as a Non-Executive Independent Director of Tokyo Cement Company (Lanka) PLC.

Dr. Arittha Wikramanayake is a veteran Corporate and M&A lawyer and heads the Firm's corporate and acquisitions practice. During his tenure as the Director General of the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC), he played a pivotal role in the development and formulation of fundamental laws, regulations and policies - including the formulation of the Takeovers and Mergers Code. He thereafter served as the Precedent Partner of Nithya Partners (Attorneys-at-Law) for nearly 25 years, where he was the driving force in consolidating its position as one of the dominant corporate law firms in Sri Lanka. As one of the leading capital market experts in the country, Dr. Wikramanayake has served in various key regulatory and policy formulating bodies including the Sri Lanka Accounting and Monitoring Standards Board, the Public Enterprises Reform Commission and Committees for the formulation of Codes of Corporate Governance. He also served as the Chairman of the Company Law Advisory Commission, a Member of the Advisory Commission on Intellectual Property Law and as a Member of the National Trade Negotiation Committee appointed by the Cabinet of Sri Lanka to negotiate Free Trade Agreements with Singapore, India, China and Thailand. He is presently a member of the Law Commission of Sri Lanka. In addition, he has been consistently ranked as a leading individual in the fields of Corporate and M&A by Chambers & Partners and the Legal 500 Asia Pacific.

Dr. Wikramanayake received his professional education at the Sri Lanka Law College and was admitted to the Bar in 1981. He thereafter served as a State Counsel with the Attorney General's Department of Sri Lanka till he assumed his position as the Director General of the Securities and Exchange Commission. During this period, he received LL.M degrees from the Vrije Universiteit (Brussels, Belgium), the University of Georgia (Athens, USA) as well as a Master's in Law and Diplomacy (MALD) from the Fletcher School of Law and Diplomacy, Tufts University (USA). Furthermore, in 2013 he was awarded a Doctorate from the University of Colombo, Sri Lanka.

Professor Malik Ranasinghe is an Emeritus Professor at the University of Moratuwa and Vice President/President elect of the National Academy of Sciences Sri Lanka. He is a Chartered Engineer and Fellow of the Institution of Engineers, Sri Lanka, Fellow of the National Academy of Sciences, Sri Lanka, Fellow of the Institute of Project Managers, Sri Lanka and Graduate Member of Sri Lanka Institute of Directors.

Prof. Ranasinghe graduated with BSc Eng, (Hons). in Civil Engineering from the University of Moratuwa and obtained his MSc and PhD from the University of British Columbia, Vancouver, Canada in Civil Engineering Economics as a Canadian Commonwealth Scholar. He was awarded the DSc (Honoris Causa) by the University of Moratuwa, Sri Lanka in 2024.

Prof. Ranasinghe is the former Vice Chancellor of the University of Moratuwa, and former Chairman of the Information and Communication Technology Agency (ICTA) of Sri Lanka, He is former Chairman of the Committee of Vice-Chancellors and Directors of Sri Lanka, Commission Member of the University Grants Commission, Council Member of the National Research Council, Council Member of the Association of Commonwealth Universities, former Dean of the Faculty of Engineering, and Chairman, Centre of Excellence in Project Management at the University of Moratuwa. He is a former Fellow of the National University of Singapore.

Since 2003, Prof. Ranasinghe has been involved continuously with the corporate sector in Sri Lanka. He is an independent non-executive Director of Pan Asia Bank PLC and ACL Cables PLC, former Chairman of Sampath Bank PLC, and former independent non-executive Director of Access Engineering PLC, Resus Energy PLC, Teejay Lanka PLC, United Motors Lanka PLC, Sampath Bank PLC, Hemas Power PLC, Lanka IOC PLC, and the Colombo Stock Exchange.

Ajith E Tudawe has combined strategic management, entrepreneurial initiative, and long-term institutional stewardship in shaping Sri Lanka's private tertiary healthcare sector. As Executive Chairman of Ceylon Hospitals PLC (CHPLC), the publicly listed parent of DURDANS HOSPITAL, he has been central to a 28-year trajectory of sectoral innovation, institutional strengthening, and governance reform, including the introduction of an Enterprise Governance framework that embedded Independent Non-Executive Directors (INEDs), enhanced board oversight, and strengthened accountability mechanisms.

Ajith holds a BA (Hons) degree from the CNA (UK) and is a Senior Chartered Accountant with fellowship status in England & Wales, Australia, and Sri Lanka, and Fellow Member for Life of ACCA (UK). During his presidency at ACCA (Sri Lanka) in 2003–2004, he launched the Annual Sustainability Reporting Awards Scheme, significantly elevating national sustainability reporting standards and promoting transparency, accountability, and stakeholder engagement. His leadership fostered lasting improvements across multiple industries adopting sustainability reporting practices.

Beginning in the late 1990s, he led a phased restructuring of DURDANS grounded in a disciplined Mergers & Acquisition (M&A) and consolidation strategy that resulted in the creation of Durdans Management Services Ltd (DMSL) as the ultimate holding vehicle with a controlling equity stake in DURDANS HOSPITAL. The restructuring concluded in October 2003 with the public listing of Ceylon Hospitals Ltd on the Colombo Stock Exchange, strengthening transparency, regulatory discipline, and access to capital.

With only 22,500 sqft of infrastructure at the outset, strategic real-estate acquisitions in 2003 and 2009 expanded DURDANS' footprint to nearly 500,000 sqft, enabling a full tertiary healthcare platform and supporting long-term capacity growth. Ajith pioneered Sri Lanka's first dedicated Heart Centre through a strategic alliance with a leading Centre of Excellence in New Delhi, then the largest freestanding Heart Institute in Asia.

This initiative introduced world-class cardiac care to Sri Lanka and enhanced cardiac surgery and interventional capabilities within the private sector. Subsequent expansions included the Sixth Lane facility, adding Orthopaedic Surgery, GU Surgery, Advanced ENT, and a state of the art Imaging and Radiology Department. He also introduced the Joint Commission International (JCI) accreditation framework to Sri Lankan private healthcare, with DURDANS becoming the first institution in the country to secure the JCI Gold Seal in 2014. Under Vision 2022, neurological capabilities were advanced through a Centre of Excellence in Neuroscience and the launch of DURDANS REVIVE in May 2025, a 9,000 sqft rehabilitation centre aligned with international post-surgical standards. His current governance focus is at Tudawe Holdings Ltd as Senior Non-Executive Director, emphasising family-enterprise governance, succession, investment oversight, and long-term sustainable stewardship.

In an opinion poll conducted by the "Lanka Monthly Digest" in October 2003, he was voted the most effective business leader in Sri Lanka since Sri Lanka gained Independence in 1948. The Lanka Monthly Digest had previously, in 1998, selected him as the "Sri Lankan of the Year."

He was conferred the National Honour of Desamanya (Titular) by Her Excellency the President of Sri Lanka, in 1998, in recognition of distinguished services of a highly meritorious nature.

In 2003 Ken Balendra co-chaired the Joint-Study Group which prepared the Indo-Sri Lanka Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement that was presented to the Prime Ministers of the two countries.

He was appointed by Her Excellency the President of Sri Lanka to serve on the Task Force for Rebuilding the Nation immediately after the Tsunami disaster, focusing on the Roads and Bridges Sector.



Mrs Rohini Nanayakkara obtained her BA 2nd Class Honours Degree from the University of Peradeniya, Sri Lanka and a Diploma in French from the Chamber of Commerce, Brussels. She is a Fellow of the Institute of Management & the Institute of Bankers, Sri Lanka.

She was the first woman executive to join a Commercial Bank with the rare distinction of being the first woman General Manager/CEO of a Bank in Sri Lanka and the Asian Region. At Bank of Ceylon - the largest Sri Lankan Bank, she managed a work force of 10,300 bank employees with a local branch network of 321 branches and several overseas branches. Some of the main highlights of her tenure of office as General Manager/CEO was the major restructuring and reform program of the Bank in association with international management consultants and the World Bank and also the opening of the first Sri Lankan Bank branches in India and Pakistan. She had the opportunity of working in International Banks such as Midland Bank-UK & Banque Brussels, Lambert, Brussels & working with several International banking correspondents across the globe.

She was also a Chairman/Director of several financial institutions such as the National Development Bank, DFCC Bank, Merchant Bank of Sri Lanka, the First Capital Group of Companies, NDB Venture Investments (Pvt) Limited, Ayojana Fund Management (Pvt) Limited and the Taprobane Investment Group of Companies. She was also a Director of Trans Asia Hotels Limited and the largest property development companies namely, Mireka Capital Lanka Limited and Overseas Realty Limited as a nominee of the main Singapore investor.

After her retirement from the Bank of Ceylon, she was appointed as the General Manager/CEO to set up the Private Sector Infrastructure Development Co Ltd, a company under the Ministry of Finance with World Bank assistance. Each initiative bears the mark of her courage to innovate and her ability to turn challenges into opportunities. Philanthropy, too, defines her journey. During the pandemic, she founded the Ceylon United Business Alliance (CUBA), becoming a voice of strength when the nation faltered. Her lineage in hospitality and garments, combined with twenty three years of entrepreneurial experience, continues to shape her as both leader and mentor.
